# Grad Requirements STA Policy

Students are required to take all graduation requirements for the respective year at STA unless the course has already been successfully completed elsewhere (usually at summer school or online during the summer or in a previous term).

Students must pass Christian Education 12 in order to participate in all Graduation Activities in June.

▶ Drop Deadline for Courses: Sept 28, 2023

# BC GRADUATION PROGRAM

- ▶ BC's new Graduation Program will continue to require all students to successfully complete 80 credits in grades 10, 11, and 12, and write three provincial assessments: Grade 10 Literacy, Grade 10 Numeracy and Grade 12 Literacy assessments.
- ► There will be an opportunity for students to re-write the Provincial Graduation Assessments to improve their achievement level. Until graduation, students may write a Provincial Graduation Assessment up to three times: the original attempt and two re-writes.

 Post-Secondary schools require the completion of at least six grade 12 courses of which five should be approved academic courses.

## Study Blocks & Service Blocks

- Students are required to be enrolled in at least 6 four credit courses at STA in their senior year.
- Grade 12 students may elect to have a study block.
  - Category A off campus (honour roll or effort honour roll)
  - ► Category B only on campus (library)
- Students can also apply for a School & Community Service Block. Selection is based on student experience and teacher need.

### Online Courses

- Online courses provide students with opportunities to earn extra credits or complete courses outside of the school timetable.
- ► STA recommendation is to take all academic required courses here at STA.
- ► For university admissions, online courses must be at least 50% complete before they appear on the transcript.

## Course Offerings

#### Academic Courses

- Courses from approved lists (differs by university) used to calculate post-secondary admission averages
- ▶ i.e. Chemistry 12, Calculus 12, Economics 12

#### Advanced Placement Courses

- Offered at the grade 12 level in English, Calculus and Computer Science
- Can earn first year university credits in high school
- May be used for admissions averages







# CREATE A LIST OF IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

- Unique programs or opportunities –
   Cooperative education,
   undergraduate research, combined studies, cohort programs, etc.
- Class size Contact with instructor and classmates.
- Culture of university, college or institute, city, and distance from supports.
- Religious, athletic, and extracurricular activities.

Consider starting at a smaller post-secondary school and benefit from much smaller classes, focus on teaching (not research), similar environment, lower admission requirements, university transfer or full degree options, with a highly specialized and diversity of programs.

### KEY MESSAGES TO STUDENTS

▶ Universities will look at your grades in nearly ALL your academic Gr.11 and Gr.12 courses.

- ▶ Particular attention to courses related to what you want to study at university. If you have the course at both the Gr.11 and Gr.12 level, more emphasis will be placed on the Gr.12 grade.
- ▶ Be aware that having the highest grades is not the only way to get in – challenging yourself by taking more courses or more rigorous courses can also be beneficial.



✓ UBC recommends 6 grade 12 level classes, academic and/or non-academic to demonstrate course load. (English 12 + 5) This is separate from all other transcript assessments.
