S.T.A. MUSIC DEPARTMENT





The Music Department achieved several notable successes this year despite facing some significant challenges, the biggest of which was an inability to present live in-person performances. This was a huge disappointment given the caliber of our ensembles this year, but our online performances are being viewed regularly.

Our band and choir classes operated with numerous new restrictions including additional cleaning, physical distancing, and polycarbonate shields. We were able to hold band and choir classes every day, all year long with no resulting illness. In December, our Concert Bands, Choirs and Jazz Ensembles presented an online Christmas Concert which have, to date received more than 600 views.

In April, our Senior Concert Band participated in the virtual Vancouver Kiwanis Festival and received a Gold Award. Our Grade 8 and 9 Concert Bands performed as part of MusicFest Canada's virtual festival. Our Junior and Senior Jazz Ensembles also participated and received Silver and Gold Awards respectively. Our choirs participated in the Kiwanis Choral Festival and a European Music Festival.

The Senior Concert Band and Senior Jazz Ensemble were invited to perform as part of the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra's Day Of Music and their performances can be viewed here:

Finally, our Senior Concert Band and Senior Jazz Ensemble have recorded nine songs each for release on a limited edition CD, which will be available soon.









