- External Credits
 - Musical Instruments, Dance, Sports
- Distributed Learning
 - Courses taken outside of STA (i.e. online, summer school)
- Language Challenge Exam
 - Challenge exams are written through the Delta School District
 - Students who have studied in Canada and have a first language other than English

Required Provincial Graduation Assessments

- Numeracy Assessment 10
- Literacy Assessment 10
- Literacy Assessment 12 – January 2023

Required for all students graduating in June 2023.

Assessment score of 1 to 4 is recorded on the ministry transcript.

UBC requires a 3 or 4 on the Literacy 12 Assessment for admission.



Post Secondary Admission

-Students must authorize the Ministry of Education to forward their student transcript to selected post-secondary institutions through their BCeID account.

-BCeID account setup is completed through in Career Life Connections class.
