Grade 11 parent volunteers will be needed to assist at the following events:

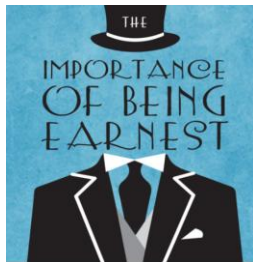
