The STA Student Council will host a Halloween school dance is on Thursday, October 27th.

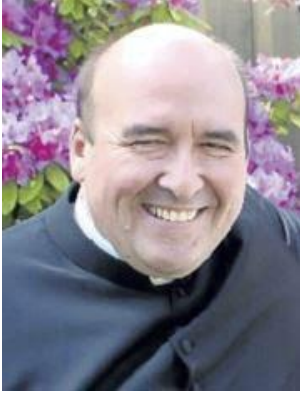
**Tickets on sale at lunch: \$5 only until Oct 26. Last chance to purchase tickets - October 27th at lunch for \$8.**

Good Shepherd Ministry relies on our donation of candy to carry out their ministry on the downtown eastside. The candy bags are used to start conversations - on any given night Good Shepherd Ministry volunteers will give out anywhere from 30-100 bags of candy.
