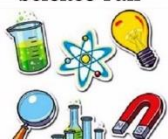


### STA Men's Hostel Ministry January 12th & 19th

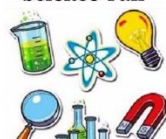

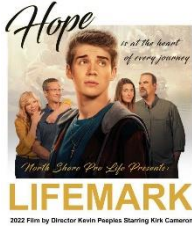
