
- 1. Components

Assessment score of 1 to 4 is recorded on the ministry transcript




Post Secondary Admission


-Students must authorize the Ministry of Education to forward their student transcript to selected post-secondary institutions through their BCeID account.


-Students will set up their BCeID accounts in Career Life Connections class in October.


