# **STA Cafeteria**



Breakfast and lunch is available at the STA School Cafeteria every day! All food is prepared daily, with a selection of daily menu items and daily specials. Students are able to purchase items with cash, debit or credit

card. STA gift cards can also be purchased at the office and used in the cafeteria.

Breakfast items are: bacon or sausage egg sandwiches, hash browns, tater tots and pastries.

Daily menu items include hamburgers, hotdogs, fries, poutine, salads, a variety of sandwiches and wraps, and veggies & dip. New additions to the daily menu are: chicken caesar salad, potato salad on a bed of lettuce and chef salad.

In addition to daily cafeteria menu items, September 18-22 weekly specials are:
